

GOSA School Grades Reports



This is a friendly reminder that the link to the Governor's Office of Student Achievement (GOSA) School Grades Report for your districts and all schools should be posted to your district website by December 31, 2018. Please consider the following points to help as this requirement is completed:

- The link should be easy for parents and the community to locate.
- The link(s) should be included for all schools, not just Title I schools.
- New 2018 data will not be updated until after January. The link is live and will automatically update to the new data, when available.
- As a best practice, also post the link on each school's website.
- When placing your report card link on your website, ensure that the link is in a language and format that parents can understand.
